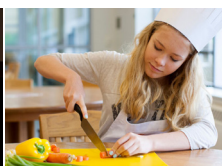

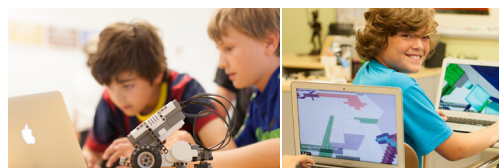

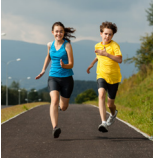

Applications will be accepted at any time, on a first-come, first-serve basis and enrollment is determined by postmark date. If you need an additional application, you may download a copy at EASummer.com. Applications will not be accepted by fax. **The balance of the tuition is due by April 1, 2016.**

FAMILY, GROUP & REFERRAL DISCOUNTS

A 5% Family Discount is given to families enrolling 2 or more participants. This discount applies to each participant after the first in your immediate family. (The first child is the participant with the higher tuition.) To receive the 5% Group Discount, send three or more applications in the same envelope. CANCELLATIONS & CHANGES DEADLINE: APRIL 1, 2016

If you need to cancel your child's enrollment, you must notify us in writing by **April 1, 2016** in order to receive a refund. Full cancellations made on or prior to this date are subject to a \$50 processing fee per child. If a cancellation is made after **April 1, 2016** and before **May 2, 2016** we will issue you a credit for all tuition fees paid, valid through the following calendar year. Your credit is transferable to any family member and may be used for any ESF Camp program. No refunds will be given out after May 2, 2016 regardless of your registration date. Changes in enrolled weeks are based on availability.

PLEASE READ AND SIGN BELOW:
